Position Title: Project Team Assistant (up to 3 positions)

Details: Full time (40 hours/week);

Tasks and Responsibilities: Assist the 2017 Shuswap Trail Alliance regional trail stewardship program.

Tasks include coordination of volunteer scheduling, project set-up, volunteer hosting, trail construction, maintenance, environmental monitoring, promotion, daily reporting, safety management, and liaison with community partners.

Project Team Assistants works under direct supervision of the Shuswap Trail Alliance project manager. Supervision includes the STA leaders training orientation and ongoing mentorship, personal work goal setting, program development theory and practice, leadership skill development, productivity management, in-field monitoring, hazard assessment and safety supervision.

Eligibility: the candidate must be a current secondary or post-secondary student returning to studies in the fall.

Applicable fields of study: Tourism and Recreation, Biology, Forestry, Environmental Sciences, Education, Event and Project Management, Outdoor/Eco-Education and Programming, Recreational Planning, Trail Design and Construction, Restoration, and Risk Management.
